

WALKER COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY
MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 17, 2014

The Walker County Republican Party met June 17, 2014 in the Wallace Building at Lee and Gordon Mills. Chairman Dean Kelley called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.
