

WALKER COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY  
MINUTES  
January 20, 2015

The January Meeting of the Walker County Republican Party was held in the Jewel Room at the Chickamauga Public Library. Chairman Dean Kelley called the meeting to order at 6:35 P. M.

Glen Wolinsky gave the invocation and Alan Painter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Secretary Judy Grammer called the roll. Those attending were: Chairman Dean Kelley, First Vice Chairman John Carpenter, Second Vice Chairman Nathan Smith, Treasurer Cathie Kelley by proxy, Secretary Judy Grammer, Mountain Precinct Chairman Mike Chambers, Chattanooga Valley Precinct Chairman Tina Painter by proxy, Kensington Precinct Chairman Glen Wolinsky and Immediate Past Chairman Alan Painter. A quorum was established.

Walker County Tax Commissioner Carolyn Walker was recognized.

Motion was made, seconded and passed to waive reading of the minutes and to approve them as posted on our website.

Jim Buckner, Chairman of the Walker County Elections Board said they were looking for a new location in Rock Spring. The gym where elections are currently being held is not working out, ie, problems with heating and cooling, plumbing, and cleanliness.

Nathan Smith announced he was a candidate for Chairman of the 14<sup>th</sup> District.

Motion was made, seconded and passed that we hold our future meetings in the Jewel Room at the Chickamauga Public Library.

Chairman Kelley announced the interim convention committee chairmen as follows: Arrangements, Cathie Kelley; Registrations, Judy Grammer (Ales Campbell was recruited to help); Sergeant at Arms, John Carpenter; Credentials, Alan Painter; Nominating, Nathan Smith; Rules, Matthew Williamson; and Resolutions, Mike Cameron.

Glen Wolinsky presented four options for us to consider as advance registrations and methods of payments for the upcoming county convention. Motion was made, seconded and passed to use Event Brite for both registration and payment of advance registration for the convention. Glen Wolinsky is to order two readers for PayPal for our use in registering those paying at the door of the convention.

Chairman Kelley made appointments to fill vacancies on the county committee as follows: Doug Grammer, Precinct Chairman; Ales Campbell, Center Post Precinct Chairman; Steve Ellis, Chickamauga Precinct Chairman, and Mike Cameron, Rossville Precinct Chairman. These are to be voted on at the February meeting subject to those appointed accepting the appointments.

Glen Wolinsky announced he would be resigning as Kensington Precinct Chairman.
