

WALKER COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY
MINUTES
FEBRUARY 17, 2015 MEETING

The February meeting of the Walker County Republican Party met on February 17th in the Jewel Room at the Chickamauga Library. Chairman Dean Kelley called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

Nathan Smith gave the invocation and Doug Grammer led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Secretary Judy Grammer called the roll. Those in attendance were: Chairman Dean Kelley, First Vice Chairman John Carpenter, Second Vice Chairman Nathan Smith, Treasurer Cathie Kelley, Secretary Judy Grammer, Immediate Past Chairman Alan Painter, Center Post Precinct Chairman Ales Campbell, Chattanooga Valley Precinct Chairman Tina Painter, and Armuchee Valley Precinct Chairman Jim Pope by proxy. A quorum was established.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the agenda be adopted.

Treasurer Cathie Kelley gave the treasurer's report. Motion was made, seconded and carried to accept the report.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to waive reading of the minutes and to adopt them as they are posted on our website.

There are two candidates for Chairman of the Walker County Republican Party. Doug Grammer and Matt Williamson gave a presentation on why they wanted to be chairman.

First Vice Chairman John Carpenter thanked everyone for their condolences in the death of his mother. Chairman Kelley read a card from the family expressing gratitude for the flowers the party sent.

Second Vice Chairman Nathan Smith had two announcements. One, he is running for Chairman of the Fourteenth District and two, as chairman of the interim nominating committee, asked if anyone wanted to be considered as an officer or as a delegate or alternate to the district and state conventions to contact him or if they wanted to recommend someone else.

Chairman Kelley gave the number of delegates allotted to each precinct for the county convention. Immediate Past Chairman Alan Painter said he had secured a keynote speaker, and that Mr. John Howard, Walker County's representative on North Georgia Electric Membership Co-op would be answering any questions about NGEMC. Doug Grammer presented a proposal to send out post cards to die-hard republicans notifying them of the convention. Motion was made, seconded and carried to send out 2000 post cards for a sum not to exceed \$1000.00. A tentative work date was set for February 28 to stick labels on the post cards and to stamp them.

Matt Williamson reported on the four proposed amendments to our county rules. Motion was made, seconded and carried to adopt the amendments submitted.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to accept Glen Wolinsky's resignation as Kensington Precinct Chairman.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to confirm the selection of Ales Campbell as Center Post Precinct Chairman and Mike Cameron as Rossville Precinct Chairman.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:20 P. M.
