

**Resolution for the Nullification of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
Act, AKA Obamacare**

***WHEREAS**, the TENTH AMENDMENT to the U.S. Constitution prohibits the Federal Government from assuming any powers not specifically delegated to it by the U.S. Constitution, and*

***WHEREAS**, the NINTH AMENDMENT to the U.S. CONSTITUTION guarantees to the people rights Not enumerated in the U.S. CONTITUTION and reserves to the people of Georgia those rights, and*

***WHEREAS**, the United States Supreme Court has ruled in NATIONAL FEDERATION OF INDEPENDENT BUSINESS v. SEBELIUS, 567 S. CT.11-393 (2012), that “the legitimacy of Congress’s exercise of the spending power...rests on whether the State voluntarily and Knowingly accepts the terms of the contract,” and*

***WHEREAS**, Republican Governor Nathan Deal has refused to establish a state-run healthcare Exchange;*

***THEREFORE LET IT BE RESVOLVED**, that we the REPUBLICAN PARTY OF WALKER COUNTY GEORGIA go on record in the support of the NULLIFICATION of the PATIENT PROTECTION and AFFORDABLE CARE ACT, also known as OBAMACARE, and do hereby request that the Governor, Lt. Governor and Speaker of the House, be requested to take appropriate action to do so, and This resolution be forwarded to the Governor, Lt.
