

A Resolution Urging The Walker County Board of Elections  
To Increase Voter Access to Early Voting

WHEREAS, equal access to the ballot box by legally qualified voters in Walker County is essential to a functional constitutional republic, and

WHEREAS, the Republican Party believes that early voting allows legally qualified voters to exercise their civic duty in a time frame that is easier for them, and

WHEREAS, legally qualified voters who reside in the northern end of Walker County may have difficulty in casting their ballot during a runoff during the early voting time frame due to a lack of satellite early voting precincts; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by these Republicans of Walker County, in Convention assembled, strongly urge the two Republican appointed representatives to the Walker County Board of Elections work with their colleagues to open up access during the early voting period of a run-off election by establishing satellite early voting sites that would be more convenient to the legally qualified voters of Walker County, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Convention secretary transmit this resolution to the two Republican appointed representatives to the Walker County Board of Elections.
